The Falls Angels is a select softball
program for girls 8 to 17 years old in
the area of Menomonee Falls.

Who are the Falls Angels?

The Falls Angels is a select softball program made up of girls from the ages of 8 to 17 who live in the vicinity of Menomonee Falls. Our teams play in the MMFL (Metro Milwaukee Fast Pitch League) and in local and state tournaments. The competition ranges from local select teams to teams that consistently compete at state and national levels.

How competitive is the program and how does it compare to recreational leagues?

Girls who participate in the Falls Angels program will receive instruction from dedicated and knowledgeable coaches plus will have plenty of opportunity to develop through near year around practice and lots of game play. As a result, girls with average skills improve dramatically over the course of one year in comparison to their peers in recreational leagues. Moreover, girls with above average talent will better position themselves for future play at higher levels.

Can my daughter play in Falls Angels and either Select Soccer or Little League?

Many of the Falls Angels are very good at and compete in more than one sport. The Select Soccer season does overlap the softball schedule in the month of June but parents have stated this is less than a conflict than it would be for Little League which overlaps 2 months and has many practice and game conflicts.

Frequently Asked Questions



What is the time commitment?

Girls who participate in this program are expected to attend *all practices and games*. Pitchers and catchers start in November or December each year and practice once a week. The rest of the team starts in early January and usually practices once a week indoors until the weather starts to cooperate. Once this happens (usually in April), we move outdoors and practices are usually bumped up to twice a week. U10 and U12 usually start the season with a tournament around Memorial Day and the older divisions will start playing games once school lets out. League play begins in June and concludes in late July and consists of 6 to 7 double headers which are played once a week. Tournaments are played once or twice a month leaving other weekends free of games. The season commences usually with a final tournament in early August. All said and done, teams usually play 30 to 40 games per season.

What is the financial commitment?

On the average, the cost for each player will be approximately \$300. This cost can (and should) be offset by fundraising and by soliciting sponsorships.

Who is eligible to play?

Any girl that meets the age requirement from the ages of 8 to 16 is welcome to try out for our 2010 rosters. A player's age as of December 31 determines the age in which the player is eligible to play the *following* year. For example, if you turn 13 on Jan 15, 2010, you would be eligible to play on the U12 team for the 2010 season. Our teams are currently comprised of players in and out of the Menomonee Falls. We do NOT restrict players from outside of Menomonee Falls from participating on our team(s).

How are the rosters determined and how many players will be on each team?

Tryouts will be held in Mid-August to determine the following year's roster. All interested players must attend a tryout. Players will be evaluated on their fundamental skills in the areas of fielding, hitting, throwing, and field awareness. Speed, quickness, effort and especially attitude will also factor in to the decision. Rosters will be limited to 11-13 players in order to maximize each player's participation in the games. Coaches from all age divisions are active in the decision making process.

Where do the Falls Angels Play?

Approximately half of the 12 -14 league games are played at "home" which is Oakwood Park in Menomonee Falls. The remainder of league games is played within 1 hour driving time to such areas as Germantown, New Berlin, Waukesha, and Racine. The tournament schedule will be determined by coaches and families but typically consist of 3 to 4 local tournaments and 1 overnight tournament.
